BOARD TO CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE FY2024 BUDGET AND VOLUNTARY ASSESSMENT

PROJECTS: PROP 68 WATER PROJECTS UPDATE

Mr. Samuelson reported that the engineering proposal was received from Summers Engineering for the groundwater recharge study. The breakdown is \$56,800 for the geotechnical work by See's Consulting & Testing, Inc. and \$8,600 for the site suitability report from Summers Engineering. The total proposal is \$65,400. The proposal has been signed and the work will be scheduled as soon as possible.

GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY AGENCY UPDATE

Mr. Samuelson showed a draft revised sustainability zone map and stated that the subbasin is looking at three different aquifers: above the Corcoran Clay (CC), below the CC, and outside of the CC. The map shows the Amsterdam Water District (AWD) boundary is in the area that has low groundwater level change since 2015.

Director Bert Crane Jr: Director Crane voiced his concern with district staff related to the following items:
